Bishop's Award of Excellence

"extending our ministry to children and youth in the community"

The Bishop's Award of Excellence is established for the purpose of recognizing congregations and units within the United Methodist Church that extend their ministry to children and youth by creating a faith based environment for children, youth, their families and their leaders to participate in the following civic youth-serving agencies: Girl Scouts of the USA, Camp Fire USA, 4-H, and Boy Scouts of America.

The Bishop's Award application along with the documentation of the below criteria shall be forwarded to the Annual Conference Scouting Coordinator by the local church scouting coordinator. The application should be made after January 1 for the pervious calendar year.

The Annual Conference Scouting Coordinator will process the application through the presiding Bishop's office and then forward the application to the General Commission on United Methodist Men in Nashville.

The Annual Conference Scouting Coordinator, in consultation with the presiding Bishop, shall arrange the presentation of the award to the local congregation and unit. It is recommended that the award be presented or acknowledge at the next regular session of annual conference.

Criteria

- 1. Local Congregation shall designate a professing member of the congregation as the Local Church Scouting Coordinator, Note: 1253 2004 UM Book of Discipline Charge Conference may elect a Scouting Coordinator,
- 2. The Local Church Scouting Coordinator in consultation with the pastor shall implement a plan to promote, enroll, counsel, and mentor youth in the God and Country religious emblem programs.
- 3. The Local Church Scouting Coordinator shall include along with the application for Bishop's Award of Excellence a report of the plan of implementation developed in criteria #2 with the number of youth working towards and/or having completed the God and Country religious emblem programs.
- 4. The Local Church Scouting Coordinator in consultation with the pastor shall arrange participation in the Scouting Ministries Sunday(s) for Girl Scouts and Boy Scout units. The congregation through the Local Church Scouting Coordinator should offer an appropriate celebration opportunity for Camp Fire USA and 4 – H units. (An appropriate celebration opportunity could be a special dinner sponsored by the congregation to affirm the work of the Camp Fire USA and 4-H units.)
- 5. The unit shall complete a service project with a missional connection to the congregation's ministry. The project shall be developed in consultation with the pastor or a designated staff/layperson.
- 6.The unit is encouraged to participate in religious practices during activities, while fostering respect and understanding for all faiths within the unit. Religious practices may include, but are not limited to the following: the God and Country programs; prayer at meal and/or meetings; designation of an adult chaplain and a youth "chaplain aid;" and, when appropriate, worship services or devotionals during extended activities.
- 7.The Local Church Scouting Coordinator and unit leader(s) shall meet to review annually the scouting ministry of the local church with the pastor or designated staff/layperson. The meeting is to encourage a an effective faith based ministry that includes program standards set by the civic youth-serving organization(s) along with appropriate leader training; implementation of youth protection standards (this includes any standards established by the local congregation); and review of the signed partnership agreement(s), either required and/or optional.

Note: ¶256.4a 2004 UM Book of Discipline encourages signed partnership agreements.
