RESOLUTION FOR THE CLOSURE OF KIMBROUGH UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

Demopolis District – Lack of financial viability

WHEREAS the Kimbrough United Methodist Church (2230), located in Wilcox County, has had a long and proud history but has been declining in membership and attendance for years; and

WHEREAS the district superintendent has recommended closing the Kimbrough United Methodist Church and recommended transfer of membership to the church of their choice; and

WHEREAS the consent to close has been granted by the presiding bishop, a majority of district superintendents, and the district board of church location and building, in accordance with Paragraph 2549.2.4.b of the 2016 Book of Discipline; and

WHEREAS Kimbrough United Methodist Church has a reversionary deed;
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Kimbrough United Methodist Church be closed effective May 11, 2022, and that all real and personal, tangible and intangible property of Kimbrough United Methodist Church immediately shall vest in the annual conference board of trustees, who shall deed the property to the original donor of the property.

RESOLUTION FOR THE CLOSURE OF SIMPSON CHAPEL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

Demopolis District – Disaffiliation

WHEREAS the Simpson Chapel United Methodist Church (2400), located in Perry County, Alabama, has sought disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church outlined in paragraph 2553 in the 2016 Book of Discipline;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Simpson Chapel UMC be closed effective June 13, 2022, subsequent to the disaffiliation approval at annual conference 2022.

RESOLUTION FOR THE CLOSURE OF STREET MEMORIAL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

Dothan District – Lack of financial viability

WHEREAS the Street Memorial United Methodist Church (3387), located in Barber County, Alabama, has had a long and proud history and has been declining in membership and attendance for years; and

WHEREAS the district superintendent has recommended closing the Street Memorial United Methodist Church and recommended transfer of membership to the church of their choice; and

WHEREAS the consent to close has been granted by the presiding bishop, a majority of district superintendents, and the district board of church location and building, in accordance with Paragraph 2549.2.4.b of the 2016 Book of Discipline;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Street Memorial United Methodist Church be closed effective July 30, 2021, and that all real and personal, tangible and intangible property of Street Memorial United Methodist Church immediately shall vest in the annual conference board of trustees, who shall gift (transfer) the property to the local Green’s Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department for use as a community center with the understanding that it will reimburse the Dothan District Trustees in the amount of expenses it has experienced since the church closed in June 2021, including all legal fees associated with gifting (transferring) the property.
