AN EXPLOSIVE IDEA: WE CAN ENDURE HARDSHIP WITH JOY

(Guest Editorial by Walter Albritton (paraphrased) From Altar Call - Opelika-Auburn News, August 4, 2013) Walter reported that his copy of *The New Testament in Modern English* by J. B. Phillips, given to him by a dear friend and fellow pastor, Jim Connor, is now tattered as he received it in 1967. But recently he began digging into the truth of Colossians 1:11-14 and after reading this scripture in the *New International Version*, found this one to be cumbersome:

"being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption the forgiveness of sins."

Next, he turned to the J. B. P:hillips version and his heart began to sing as he read this version:

"As you live this new life, we pray that you will be strengthened from God's boundless resources, so that you will find yourselves able to pass through an experience and endure it with joy. You will even be able to thank God in the midst of pain and distress because you are privileged to share the lot of those who are living in the light. For we must never forget that he rescued us from the power of darkness and reestablished us in the kingdom of his beloved Son. For it is by his Son alone that we have been redeemed and have had our sins forgiven."

Walter stated he got excited with the concept of "passing through" a hardship as good theology. When times are tough we desire the grace to get "through the night" rather than get stranded in the pain. But, in the 23rd Psalm David speaks of walking "through" the valley of the shadow of death. That told him that God wants to help us "pass through" a hardship and get victory over it as Phillips has Paul praying that we will not only pass through a hardship, but "endure it with joy". This was a new way to suffer misfortune - to do so with joy! The word "endure" had always conjured up the idea of tolerating a problem, suffering through it and gritting your teeth to the bitter end. But Phillips injects "joy" into the ordeal! Walter stated, "That marvelous idea was suddenly it up on the billboard of my soul - God can help me endure difficulty with joy! I want that kind of faith. I have some of it. I want more! I need more!" What a great example of what can happen when we open our mind and begin searching for truth in the Holy Scriptures!!!

INVITATION TO SURVIVING SPOUSES


